Planned Parenthood is the nation's leading provider and advocate of high-quality, affordable sexual and reproductive health care for all people, as well as the nation's largest provider of sex education.

With nearly 600 health centers across the country, Planned Parenthood organizations serve all patients with care and compassion, with respect, and without judgment, striving to create equitable access to health care. Through health centers, programs in schools and communities, and online resources, Planned Parenthood is a trusted source of reliable education and information that allows people to make informed health decisions. We do all this because we care passionately about helping people lead healthier lives.

- An estimated one in five women in the U.S. has visited a Planned Parenthood health center.
- Planned Parenthood health centers provide health care that helps women prevent an estimated 355,000 unintended pregnancies in a single year.
- Planned Parenthood Global's partners provided health services to 770,000 people and trained more than 12,000 advocates.
- Planned Parenthood websites, including Planned Parenthood en español, receive an estimated 200 million visits in a single year.
- In 2021, of Planned Parenthood patients who report their income, nearly 70% live with incomes at or below 150% of the federal poverty level, the equivalent of \$39,750 a year for a family of four.
- Planned Parenthood affiliates provide the following services to 2.1 million patients – 46% of whom are people of color – including more than 5811,000 patients who identify as Latino and over 360,000 patients who identify as Black:
 - o family planning counseling and contraception to nearly 1.57 million patients
 - o more than 900,000 pregnancy tests
 - o nearly 230,000 Pap tests
 - o more than 190,000 breast exams
 - o screenings to nearly 70,000 patients whose cancer was detected early or whose abnormalities were identified and addressed
 - o more than 4.41 million tests and treatments for sexually transmitted infections, including more than 712,000 HIV tests, and diagnoses of more than 264,000 STIs
 - o more than 543,000 emergency contraception kits
 - o education and outreach programs to 567,000 people, in spite of pandemic constraints on in-person instruction
 - o more than 5.6 million engagements with digital education tools and video resources
