Preparing for a Post-Roe World by Chelly Hegan, UHPP President/CEO

Across the country, we have seen relentless attacks on abortion, abortion access, and unprecedented laws that defy logic. Still, as we wait for a ruling from the Supreme Court on a direct challenge to Roe in Mississippi, it seems unreal that we may very soon experience a country where one's rights, autonomy and basic freedoms will be radically different depending on what state they live in. Since the appointment of Justices Gorsuch, Kavanaugh and Barrett this scenario has become real for our supporters, and while we have been planning for this for a long time, **only 33% of Americans believe that Roe is under direct threat.**

As of today, far too many people in our country have lost–or are losing–their constitutional right to abortion. More restrictive laws, mandatory waiting periods, travel roadblocks, and financial barriers are in place across the country. But this is not new; this fight has been building for decades, and this fight will never end because there are some people and policymakers who want to control women and people of color. People who do not believe you are a full citizen if you are poor if you live in a rural community or if you are gender nonconforming.

As we wait for the Supreme Court to render a verdict, which is not expected until spring, people in Texas STILL have no access to abortion. We are grateful that NY passed the Reproductive Health Act, but it is a small comfort when we imagine what people are going through



"The right to safe and legal abortion has been the law of the land for nearly 50 years and is now very much a part of the fabric of our country. Generations have grown up under this precedent and yet here we are, with a fight on our hands. It's about controlling bodies. It's about turning back the clock and putting people back in their 'less than place.' These are the stakes, but we are not about to let the clock turn back. We've come too far to let that happen."

Birth Contol & More From Your Phone: Planned Parenthood Direct App



UHPP launched PPDirect, a mobile health care app that allows patients to receive birth control pills through at-home delivery to people at home and UTI treatment delivered to local pharmacies, without ever having to go into a health center for an appointment. Patients just need to download the free PPDirect app to their Android or iPhone. The links can be found at uhpp.org.
