A YEAR WITHOUT ROE.

Last June, the Supreme Court issued the devastating decision that **overturned Roe v. Wade** and the federal constitutional right to abortion, allowing states to ban essential health care – which stripped tens of millions of people of the right to make their personal medical decisions, and left patients desperate, confused, and fearful.

A year later, we're still learning what this new post-Roe environment will look like across the country. And here in northern New England, we're feeling the effects of this devastating decision now that 1 in 3 people live in a state without access to abortion.



The safe haven northern New England is, and the services we provide, has never been more important. With your support, PPNNE represents three of the states that are left standing – ready and able to provide a full range of sexual and reproductive health care, including birth control, STI testing and treatment, and abortion care.

On behalf of all who rely on us for care, thank you for supporting PPNNE! We provided abortion care to **3,014 patients this year.**

We instituted changes to our procedural abortion program to **center the patient experience** and **reduce the duration of a visit.**

We began offering telehealth visits for medication abortion. To date, 350 patients from our region have utilized this program.

We are increasing access to abortion by expanding our medication abortion program to our Derry, NH and St. Johnsbury, VT health centers.

A patient from the Midwest traveled to northern New England for her abortion because she felt safer here. To date, we have had patients from 24 other states travel to PPNNE for abortion care.
