A specific bequest

You can establish a bequest of a particular dollar amount or asset.

Recommended language: "I give, bequeath, and devise (dollar amount or description of gift) to Upper Hudson Planned Parenthood or its successor, now or formerly in the City of Albany, 855 Central Avenue, in the State of New York, to be used for its general purposes."

A residuary bequest

You can give all or part of the property remaining in your estate after debts, expenses, and specific bequests are made:

Recommended language: "I give, bequeath, and devise (all, or ___ percent of) the rest, residue, and remainder of the property, both real and personal, wherever situated, which I may own or be entitled to at my death, to Upper Hudson Planned Parenthood or its successor, now or formerly in the City of Albany, 855 Central Avenue, in the State of New York, to be used for its general purposes."

Other ways to support our future

Naming Upper Hudson Planned Parenthood as a beneficiary of a retirement plan or life insurance policy is another way to help ensure reproductive healthcare for generations to come.
