LETTER FROM OUR CEO

Dear Friend.

This calendar year, Planned Parenthood Northern California (PPNorCal) remained strong, forward-thinking, and resilient in the face of ongoing crises. This year, against all odds, we opened the San Francisco Flagship Health Center, transitioned to the Epic Electronic Health (EHR) Record System, and expanded our impact through telehealth services, while still operating under COVID-19 safety protocols. Our success is a direct result of a dedicated Board of Directors, generous supporters like you, and our outstanding PPNorCal staff, who continue to provide life-changing care without disruption.

Though there has been much progress made, we cannot rest. We are seeing a dangerous trend of restricting abortion in our country. We are currently seeing what a post-Roe world could look like in Texas, where the U.S. Supreme Court has allowed S.B. 8 to stand, effectively banning abortion at approximately six weeks. Poll after poll demonstrates that a super majority of people in America support legal abortion, but on 12/1 the Supreme Court heard arguments on the Mississippi 15-week Abortion Ban case that could overturn or dramatically erode protections under Roe v. Wade. The nationwide attacks against reproductive health care and rights are at a crisis point. If you are interested in supporting patients in Texas and other hostile states, please consider donating to the Yellowhammer Fund, Mississippi Freedom Fund, ACR-Southeast, ACCESS REPRODUCTIVE JUSTICE, Women's Health Specialists, and Women's Reproductive Rights Assistance Project (WRRAP). You can also give to keepourclinics.org to support abortion providers, including Jackson Women's Health Organization in Mississippi.

PPNorCal, along with our other Planned Parenthood partners, is focused on strengthening California's capacity as a reproductive freedom state. Texas patients are already seeking our care, cementing our status as a safe haven for all. More than ever, we are committed to upholding our mission for the most vulnerable among us. Please join us and donate today, every dollar matters. Together, we can continue to shine as a beacon of hope for all who need us—now and into the future.

Together, we can continue to build upon the accomplishments of this year and make a direct impact on the lives of those we serve.

PPNorCal is proud to continue providing the following essential reproductive health care services this year:

- Family planning, including pregnancy testing and counseling*
- Contraception and birth control*
- STI testing, vaccines, and treatment, including PEP and PrEP to prevent HIV infection
- Infertility services*
- Abortion services and emergency contraception*
- Cancer screenings, including colposcopy and breast exams*
- Prenatal care
- Behavioral health
- Trans health services and Gender Affirming Hormone Therapy (GAHT)
- Vasectomy
- Loop Electrosurgical Excision Procedure (LEEP), a procedure that removes abnormal tissue from the cervix

The <u>San Francisco Flagship Health Center</u> provides a full range of our expert health care services, with exciting expansion of vasectomies, abortion, and behavioral health services. Our Flagship is located in the heart of San Francisco. The space allows for a higher volume of patient visits, enabling San Franciscans and surrounding communities to take advantage of expanded services.

This Flagship makes space for collaboration and innovation across PPNorCal's programs, including groundbreaking research, education, and mobilization. The Flagship reinforces our mission to increase visibility, engagement, and the ability to provide health care for low-income patients.

This modern facility and its advanced equipment and technology allow us to increase our service capacity, reduce wait times, and host gatherings in our state-of-the-art, multipurpose rooms. Our most commonly sought-after appointment types at this location are sexually transmitted infection (STI) screening and treatment, birth control consultations, pregnancy testing, and breast and cervical cancer screenings.

Community Outreach

After a year without in-person Women's Marches due to COVID-19, PPNorCal's Public Affairs and Education teams were happy to be involved in nearly a dozen Women's March events on October 2, in support of reproductive rights.

DID YOU KNOW?

Behavioral Health

Our Behavioral Health Department provides crisis counseling and ongoing supportive therapy to patients seeking help for mild to moderate mental health stressors and challenges. This includes anxiety, depression, relational concerns, feelings about reproductive health options, and adjusting to/managing life stressors. The Behavioral Health Team also works with patients coping with trauma (e.g., IPV, abuse, housing insecurities). In addition, they support patients seeking Gender Affirming Hormone Therapy (GAHT) services by assessing social and familial support as they begin their transition processes.

PPNorCal therapists also work collaboratively with the Contra Costa Prenatal Program by providing assessments, health education, and emotional support to prenatal patients. Our goal is to connect prenatal patients with needed resources to progress with a healthy pregnancy and delivery. Prenatal counselors provide ongoing counseling services to prenatal patients and couples as needed.

DIVERSITY, EQUITY, & INCLUSION

DEI is at the core of PPNorCal's mission of respecting and honoring all people. We are dedicated to intentionally creating an inclusive and diverse environment in which we all feel valued and supported. To deepen this steadfast commitment to DEI, in 2020, PPNorCal launched monthly staff meetings dedicated to generative conversations about essential, intersectional social justice topics impacting reproductive care.

We wanted to share with you the following guide to avoid any possible confusion.



If you go to Planned Parenthood Federation of America's national website...

Approximately 50% of your gift will support health services and education here in Northern California and the other 50% of your gift will support national advocacy and education efforts.
