ARIZONA KNOW YOUR RIGHTS: REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH EDITION



You have the right to access sexual and reproductive healthcare.

If you are at least 13 years old:

- Though we encourage you to involve your parent/guardian if possible, you may attend an appointment alone, if desired.
- You can receive any form of birth control you need, emergency contraception (EC) and pregnancy testing.
- You can get tested and treated for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), including HIV.
- You can receive gender-affirming hormone therapy. The state of Arizona does not allow PPAZ to provide gender-affirming care to patients under 18, but if you have supportive guardians, you can make an appointment with <u>El Rio Health</u> located in Tucson or <u>Phoenix</u> <u>Children's Gender Support Program</u>.
- Talk with your provider to discuss ways to protect your privacy from bills or letters about your visit being sent to your house if using your parents' insurance.
- Visit SexFYI.org to find a clinic where the appointment cost will be based on your self-verified income.
- Call 855-207-7526 or visit PPAZ.org to make an appointment at your closest Planned Parenthood clinic.

Emergency Contraception (EC) Remains Legal.

- Effective up to 5 days after unprotected sex, but most effective if taken as soon as possible.
- Available over-the-counter without a prescription.
- Copper and hormonal IUDs are both effective as EC up to 5 days after unprotected sex, but insertion requires an office visit. Same day appointments are available. Call or walk-in to our health centers.

Abortion

It is legal to have an abortion in Arizona when provided by licensed physicians, with the following restrictions:

- Abortion is not permitted beyond 15 weeks of pregnancy.
- Abortion is not permitted for reasons of fetal race, sex, or genetic abnormality.
- If you are under 18 years old, a parent or legal guardian must give you permission to have an abortion. If getting the permission of a parent or guardian is not an option for you, you can seek a judicial bypass (JB) by calling the JB Helpline at 844-868-2812 or visiting ReproLegalHelpline.org/contact-the-helpline.

WATCH OUT!

Be aware of fake clinics, also known as <u>crisis</u> <u>pregnancy centers (CPCs)</u>. They're run by people who are anti-abortion and their goal is to shame, scare, or pressure you into carrying a pregnancy to term.
